What to expect

Schools+ Community

The Schools+ Community is where all the members will come together twice a year to share insights and collaborate on common challenges. The Community is comprised of representatives of governments (including ministries and local education bodies), organisations, research bodies and schools themselves.

Schools Learning Circle

The Schools Learning Circle is where school level actors (teachers and school leaders) and experts come together to discuss innovations and improvements in teaching and learning. During the first biennium, the focus will be on



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understanding innovations in pedagogy (classroom practice) and how and if these can be taken from one context to another.


